Bruce Sanderson's Recommended 2015 Burgundies

*All wines included in this report were tasted non-blind, at the properties in Burgundy. For those buying pre-arrivals, or who want to get a jump on small-production, highly allocated wines, the following wines were highlights of senior editor Bruce Sanderson's tastings—many still in barrel or otherwise unfinished—in Burgundy in January. Some 2015 whites, for example Mâconnais and Chablis, are beginning to arrive in the U.S. now. **His full tasting report on the bottled 2015 red Burgundies will be published early next year, with official scores, tasting notes and recommended drink windows.***
