This gift box, limited to 100 pieces, was created by Fornasetti, to artistically feature the iconic Clos des Mouches of Joseph Drouhin.

Piero Fornasetti was a famous painter, sculptor and interior designer from Milan. In the course of his career he produced nearly 11,000 individual works of breathtaking diversity; he was one of the 20th century's most prolific producers of art objects and furniture, and is today recognized as one of its most original creative talents.

Naturally, this style is still a strong and decisive influence on the works produced by the Fornasetti Atelier, and by his son, Barnaba. (www.fornasetti.com)

Barnaba Fornasetti wanted to highlight the value of the rich Burgundy soil, to echo the structure of its "Climats" and the strength with which they imbue Burgundy's wines, as well as the elegance and femininity that are strong themes at Joseph Drouhin.

- Two bottles of **Beaune Premier Cru Clos des Mouches "l'Ouvrée des Dames" 2005** vinified by Laurence Jobard and Véronique Drouhin on a 16th century press. As a tribute to these exceptional women, this limited edition bears the name "Ouvrée des Dames" with labels exclusively designed by Barnaba Fornasetti.
- **An original painting, numbered and signed by Barnaba Fornasetti.**
- Booklet telling the story of the famous Clos des Mouches.
- USB card with a commented slideshow illustrating the harvesting and vinification of these unique wines.
