After graduating from the Business School in Tours, he pursued technical studies at the viticultural high school in Beaune. The 1988 vintage marked his official return to the estate.

Quickly, he established a philosophy with the conversion to organic and biodynamic farming, which has become the DNA of Maison Joseph Drouhin.

In just a few years, Philippe has brought his scientific rigor and sensitivity to achieve even greater precision in expressing the Burgundian terroirs. From vine plant selection to seeking the optimal grape ripeness during the crucial harvest period, Philippe is the man

of the upstream process, ensuring that the purest fruit possible satisfies his sister Véronique and Jérôme Faure-Brac in the cellar. The winemaker then steps aside, as discretion dictates.
